REGISTRATION INFO FOR **GBYC 2021**

Here's how to register your group for the event:



ONLINE GROUP REGISTRATION | To register online, please visit the GB Resources website at www.gbresources.org, click the "Events" tab, and select GBYC. This online form should be completed by the leader of the parish or school group looking to attend GBYC.

A FEW REMINDERS | This is a high school conference, so student participants should be in grades 9-12 currently. Students **MUST** register with a parish or school group. If students wish to attend independently from a group, they must register with an adult chaperone, parent, or guardian. There is no individual lost-sheep option for students.

COST & PAYMENT | Each participant costs \$25. One group check can be written to the Diocese of Green Bay and can be mailed in one week prior to the event. Priests/clergy/religious are free.

LIABILITY FORMS | It is the group leader's responsibility to carry all of the individual student liability forms with them. The Diocese of Green Bay will not be collecting liability forms from each parish or school. Each group must provide their own adult chaperones and have their adult liability forms on hand. Our safe environment policy requires one adult chaperone (21 and over) per eight minors. Minimally, there shall be one adult chaperone for any male minors and one female adult chaperone for any female minors.
