## *A Retreat Day for Catechetical Leaders*

Kerygma Encounter is a one-day retreat designed for catechetical leaders and it can be used as a component of formation for leaders and catechists. The day features four main talks focusing on the heart of faith: **Who is God? Who is Man? Why Jesus? Union with God.**

The focus of each session is to help those in catechetical roles understand God made humans to be in relationship with him and actually share in God's divine nature. Each talk is followed by silent prayer and time to seek answers to questions that surfaced.

The focus of this retreat is to bring you to a new encounter, both in mind and heart, with Jesus Christ, in the power of the Holy Spirit, drawing closer into the heart of the Father.

Since Kerygma Encounter was developed in the Diocese of Lansing in 2015, more than fifteen hundred committed Catholics around the state of Michigan have been formed and transformed by the experience; including priests, deacons, and the Sisters of Mary Mother of the Eucharist.
